Missouri Car Accident Checklist

MMEDIATE SAFETY (First Priority)
□ Check for injuries - call 911 if anyone needs medical attention
□ Move to safety - get out of traffic if vehicles are drivable
□ Turn on hazard lights
□ Set up flares, cones, or reflective triangles if available
□ Do NOT move seriously injured people
DOCUMENT THE SCENE
□ Take photos of all vehicle damage from multiple angles
□ Photograph the accident location and road conditions
□ Capture traffic signs, signals, and street names
□ Take pictures of license plates and VINs
□ Document any visible injuries
□ Photo timestamp with newspaper or phone date if possible
□ Sketch the accident scene if safe to do so
EXCHANGE INFORMATION
For Each Driver Involved:
□ Full name and contact information
□ Driver's license number
□ Insurance company and policy number
□ Vehicle make, model, year, and color
□ License plate number
□ VIN number (if accessible)
For Witnesses:
□ Name and phone number
□ Brief statement about what they saw
□ Email address if willing to provide

POLICE REPORT
□ Call police (required if injury, death, or damage over \$500)
□ Get officer's name and badge number
□ Request accident report number
□ Ask how to obtain copy of report
□ Provide facts only - avoid admitting fault
PROTECT YOUR CLAIM
□ Seek medical attention promptly (even if feeling okay)
□ Keep all medical records and receipts
□ Report accident to your insurance company within 24-48 hours
□ Avoid giving recorded statements without legal advice
□ Don't sign anything except traffic tickets
☐ File Missouri DOR report within 30 days if uninsured driver involved
□ Keep detailed records of all accident-related expenses
□ Remember: You have 5 years to file injury claims, 3 years for wrongful death
□ Government vehicle claims must be filed within 90 days

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

DO NOT:

- Discuss details beyond basic facts
- Accept quick settlement offers

DO:

- √ Keep this checklist in your glove compartment
- ✓ Take photos even if damage seems minor
- √ Get medical attention for ANY symptoms
- ✓ Contact an attorney if injuries are serious or fault is disputed
